Art Elements and Principals Tuesday 4:45pm- 6:00pm Ages 9 -12

This class gives students the opportunity to create art samples or pieces of art based around one or two guiding principles and/or elements. Open Level Contemporary Dance Monday 5:30pm-6:30pm Ages 11-18

Thought this is an open-level class, some previous dance experience is helpful and to some degree, expected. Students must come with clothes that do not restrict them from dancing. Students may use dance shoes or dance barefoot. This is a beginner-level contemporary dance class. Techniques will be introduced with an emphasis on the importance of strength, flexibility, rhythm, musicality, memorization, and performance.

Beginning Ballet Wednesday 3:30pm-4:30pm Ages 6 -10

This class will cover the fundamentals of classical ballet techniques through learning ballet positions, posture, and vocabulary. All that is required is a love of movement. Students need to either wear socks or ballet slippers, stretchy pants or leotard and tights, a comfortable appropriate top, and their hair pulled back out of their faces.



Ballet & Jazz I Wednesday 4:30pm-5:30pm Ages 11-18

This is an introductory Ballet & Jazz combo class for older students. From fun and energetic movement of the jazz style to classical ballet techniques paired with warm ups, stretching, strengthening, turns, leaps, jumps, and runs—this class has it all!

Ballet & Jazz II Wednesday 4:30pm-6:30pm Instructor Appointed

Our Intermediate classes are typically instructor-invite-only. However, if you have previous dance experience at a high level please contact us to see if this class would be a good fit for you! This is an accelerated class for committed students. More difficult techniques will be introduced with an emphasis on the importance of strength, flexibility, rhythm, musicality, and memorization.





Beginning Hip Hop A Thursday 3:30pm-4:30pm

Beginning Hip Hop B Thursday 4:30pm-5:30pm
Ages 10-18

This class is an introduction to hip hop. The student will learn basic rhythm, coordination and basic footwork while learning how to dance to the beat of the music. Students will learn to memorize choreography by working on combinations in each class. Activities will include stretching, across the floors, simple warm-up dances, choreography, free dance, and games. The goal is for each student to feel comfortable dancing in a group setting, to gain self-confidence, and to learn how to work together as a team. Please wear clothes and shoes you can dance in. No dresses or boots! This is an upbeat and high-energy class so bring your funk!

This class is recommended for those who have attended and excelled in the intro to guitar course, or for those who have had previous outside experience with guitar, and basics thereof, such as identification of guitar parts, first-position chords, and strumming.

Intermediate Piano Wednesday

Acting I-Monologues Tuesday 4pm-5pm Ages 12-18

Students will memorize, rehearse and perform 1 minute monologues to develop auditioning skills for future performances. All notes, lessons and exercises will be dedicated to cultivating a strong foundation in theater. With Stanislavski's "Magic, if" in practice, every student will find the freedom in every role to truly make every stage their own. "

Musical Theatre Tuesday 4:15-6:15pm Ages 10 -18

In this summer Musical Theatre class children will explore multiple aspects of art such as acting, singing, and dancing. They will also learn essential techniques for performing on stage and auditioning for shows. This class builds confidence and character as they learn to express themselves through the performing arts!



Improv 101 Thursday 4:00-5:30pm Ages 10 -18

This course is an introduction to the basics of improv. While incorporating some games, students will also learn the fundamentals of what makes improvisational comedy work and create their very own unscripted scenes. Students will be encouraged to leave their worries at the door, and embark on creative journeys that push them to have fun, self reflect and potentially develop bonds with their very own community.



Improv for Kidz Friday 4pm-5pm Ages 7-11

The main focus for this class is learning new games, and how to really listen to peers to help create bigger and more fascinating worlds together. Now is the time to imagine anything and everything! Students will learn a variety of warmup improv/theater games. They will work together through exercises that focus on collaboration and design. And they will find new ways to communicate through body language and even total gibberish!

Actors Studio Friday 5:15pm-6:15pm Ages 12+

In this non-performance based class, students will learn that foundation of improvisation on stage in a group environment. Classes will have a new exercise for students to try a different approach to improv on a weekly basis.
